- Complete diagnostic assessments, Functional assessments, and LOCUS
- Collaborate with individuals and implement compassionate, culturally responsive and effective treatment plans that reflect the individual's specific needs
- Support individuals in the development of skills and strategies to address mental health concerns
- Provide collateral consultation with other important parties to ensure the ongoing support and safety for all individuals
- Provide community resources to help maximize positive experiences and support
- Maintain confidentiality and build trusting, therapeutic rapport with individuals
- Assist in the facilitation of psychotherapy groups
- Knowledge of community resources.
